



# Radicalisation Explained

**Radicalisation** is the process by which a person comes to support terrorism and extremist ideologies associated with terrorist groups.

**Prevent duty** is the name for the government's strategy to prevent people from being drawn into terrorism.

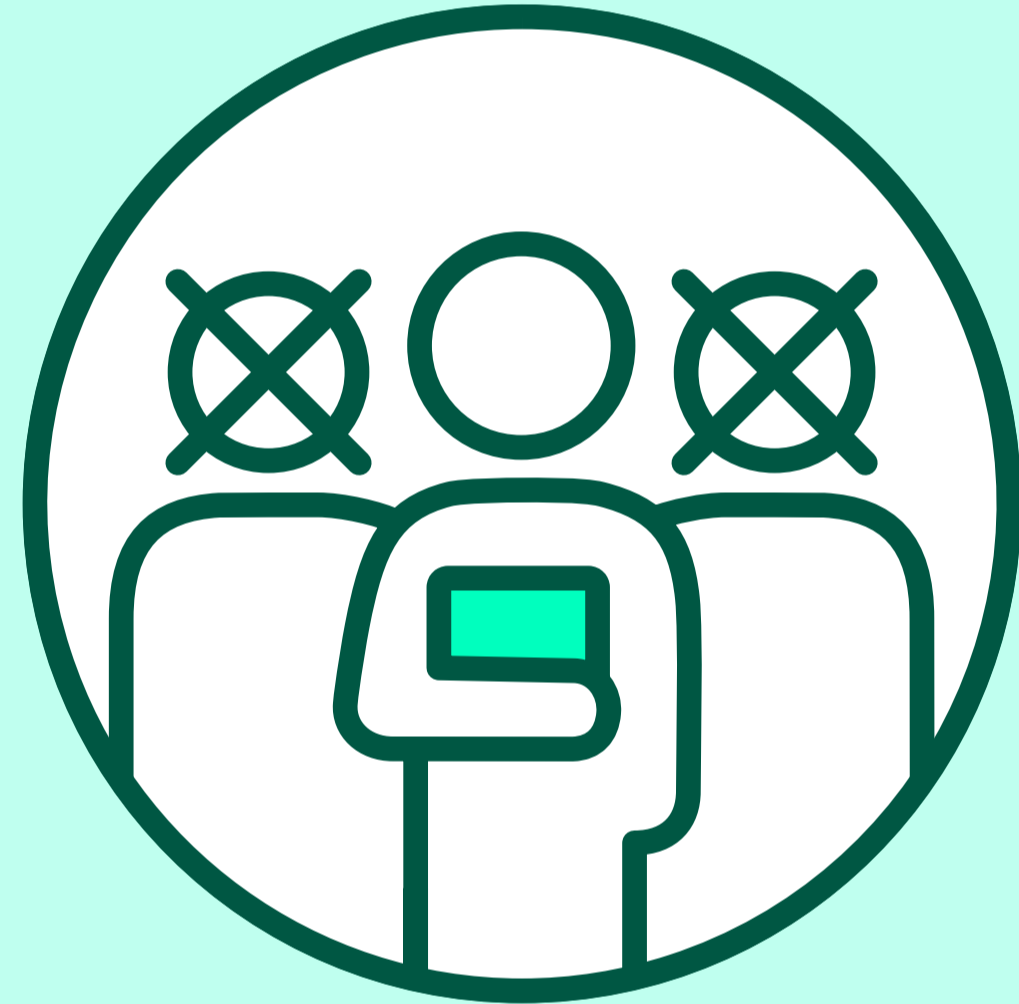
## Protecting people from **RADICALISATION** and tackling **EXTREMISM** is a team effort

**Extremist groups** are actively trying to **recruit young people** online and in the community. They seek to **exploit any vulnerability.**

OUT OF CHARACTER CHANGES IN DRESS OR BEHAVIOUR



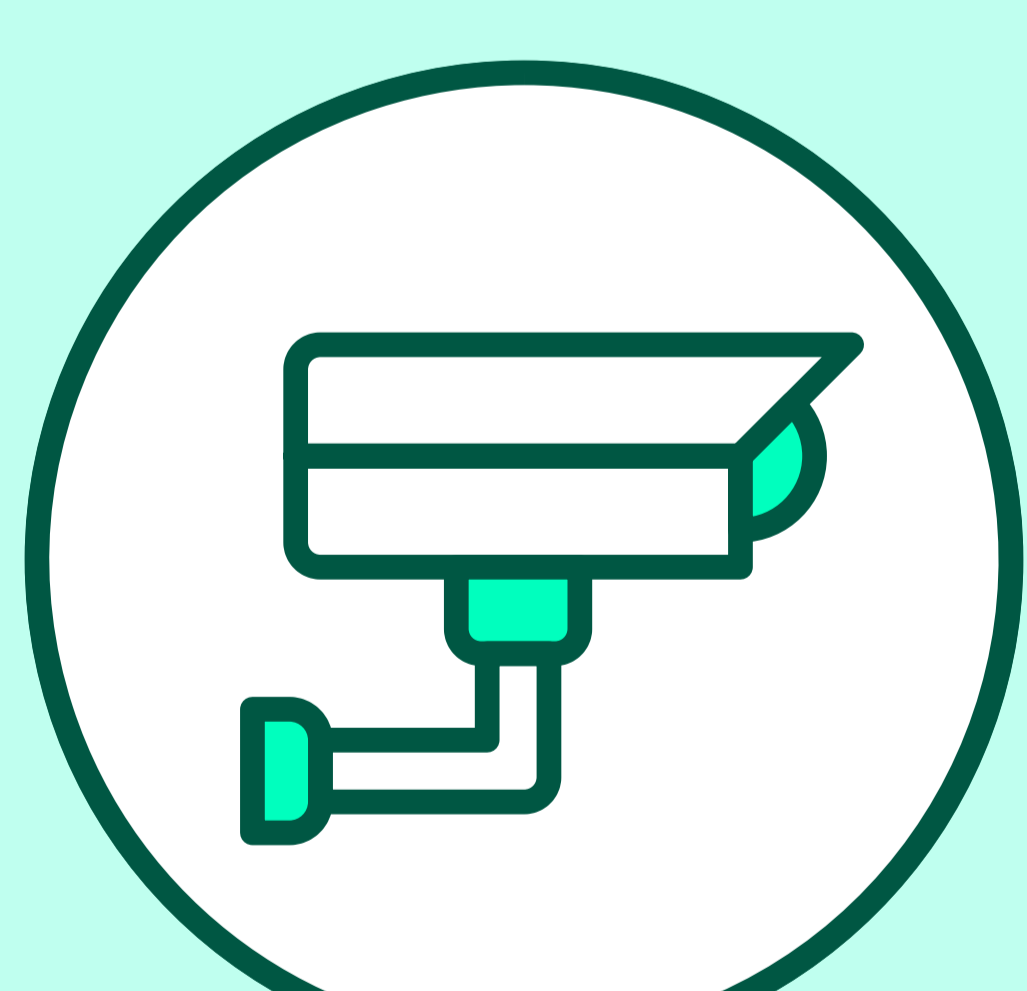
LOSING INTEREST IN OLD FRIENDS AND OLD ACTIVITIES
