- Don't be 'the show-off'. You must focus on the road at all times.
- Alcohol, drugs and high spirits are dangerous alone but whilst driving can cause serious accidents.
- Do not give in to peer pressure whilst driving.
- If you're a passenger and don't think a driver is going to be safe – do not get into the car.
- Take extra care on country roads and narrow lanes.
- Always wear your seatbelt.
- Leave at least one car space between you and the car in front at all times.
